- (13) Also referred to as Electorate Services. Includes all persons employed under the Assistants to the Members of the South Australian Parliament Enterprise Agreement.
- (14) These figures incorporate the total workforce of the Health Units (SA Health Regions) incorporated under the SA Health Care Act, which took effect on 1 July 2008. Excludes employees as a result of the integration of Workforce and Finance employees from the regional payroll to the Department of Health's payroll, April 2011.
- (15) Does not include persons employed under Special Acts and the Judicial Administration Act who work in the Industrial Court System. Although Judicial Officers are not public sector employees, they are included in this report because they receive remuneration from the State of South Australia according to decisions made by the Remuneration Tribunal.
