



## DIRECTIONS OF THE PREMIER

### UNDER SECTION 10 OF THE *PUBLIC SECTOR ACT 2009*

I, Jay Wilson Weatherill, Premier of South Australia, hereby issue the following directions under section 10 of the *Public Sector Act 2009* which bind all public sector agencies<sup>1</sup>.

#### **Cease to participate in or be a member of Self Insurers of South Australia**

---

I hereby direct Chief Executives or agency heads of South Australian Government agencies to cease to participate in or be member of Self Insurers of South Australia.

Self-Insurers of South Australia (SISA) is an incorporated association representing employers in relation to work injuries.

Currently, individual government agencies pay a yearly fee of approximately \$4,000 per year to be a member of SISA.

The Government has been seeking various avenues to improve the consistency of claims management for work injuries, including reviewing current arrangements.

Please ensure relevant staff within your agency are informed of this directive.
